Winter Break Housing Request

The winter break housing request form is intended to provide a convenient housing option to current residential students who need housing while the university is closed. Residents filling out this form need to have a spring 2022 reserved booking and will need to qualify for one of the reasons listed below in order to be granted housing throughout the winter break. Residents approved for winter break housing may be selected for surveillance testing and will be required to comply if selected. Residents will receive an e-mail confirming they have been approved or denied for winter break housing by December 4th.

Due to the first year residence halls being closed for the winter break period, students in Presidents Park, Taylor, Commonwealth, Dominion, and the University Commons will be assigned a space in the Angel Cabrera Global Center. Although every effort will be made to assign students to singles in the Angel Cabrera Global Center, students may still be assigned a roommate should there be a high demand for winter break housing.

First year students who are temporarily reassigned to the Angel Cabrera Global Center will be able to begin moving their belongings over on Friday, December 10th. Students who are relocated will need to pick up their temporary card from the Piedmont Desk prior to accessing their temporary assigned space. Students who fail to complete the move by 5:00pm on December 15th will have their winter break housing application canceled and will not be able to remain on campus throughout the break.

Criteria for receiving winter break housing:

- I am an international student and am unable to travel home before December 15th, 2021.
- My health, safety, or access to food and shelter would be at risk if not on campus.
- I am an athlete and need to remain on campus throughout the break (will need to be verified by Mason Athletics)
- I have an academic or other reason for needing to remain on campus during the winter break

Please note that the following changes to services throughout the Winter Break:

- **Dining:** Dining options throughout the break will be extremely limited. Students in traditional or suite style housing may not have access to a full kitchen, and as such, should plan to provide their own meals throughout the break.
- **Transportation:** Information regarding Mason Shuttle schedules can be found at transportation.gmu.edu.
- **HRL Desk Hours:** Services for residential students, including the Eisenhower and Piedmont Desks will have limited access/operating hours throughout the break. Students who need assistance after hours should call the number posted at their neighborhood desk.

Winter Break Housing Agreement

Students who apply for and are approved for winter break housing acknowledge the following:

- Due to the first year residence halls being closed for the winter break period, students in Presidents Park, Taylor, Commonwealth, Dominion, and the University Commons will be assigned a space in the Angel Cabrera Global Center.
- Although every effort will be made to assign students to singles in the Angel Cabrera Global Center, students may still be assigned a roommate should there be a high demand for winter break housing.
- Dining options will be extremely limited for the winter break. Meal plans are not offered for winter break and as such, students acknowledge that they are responsible for providing their own meals throughout the winter break period. - Students staying for winter break will need to adhere to all university and Housing and Residence Life policies. Students who violate the policies may be asked to leave their assigned space and will not be allowed to return until the halls open for the spring semester.
